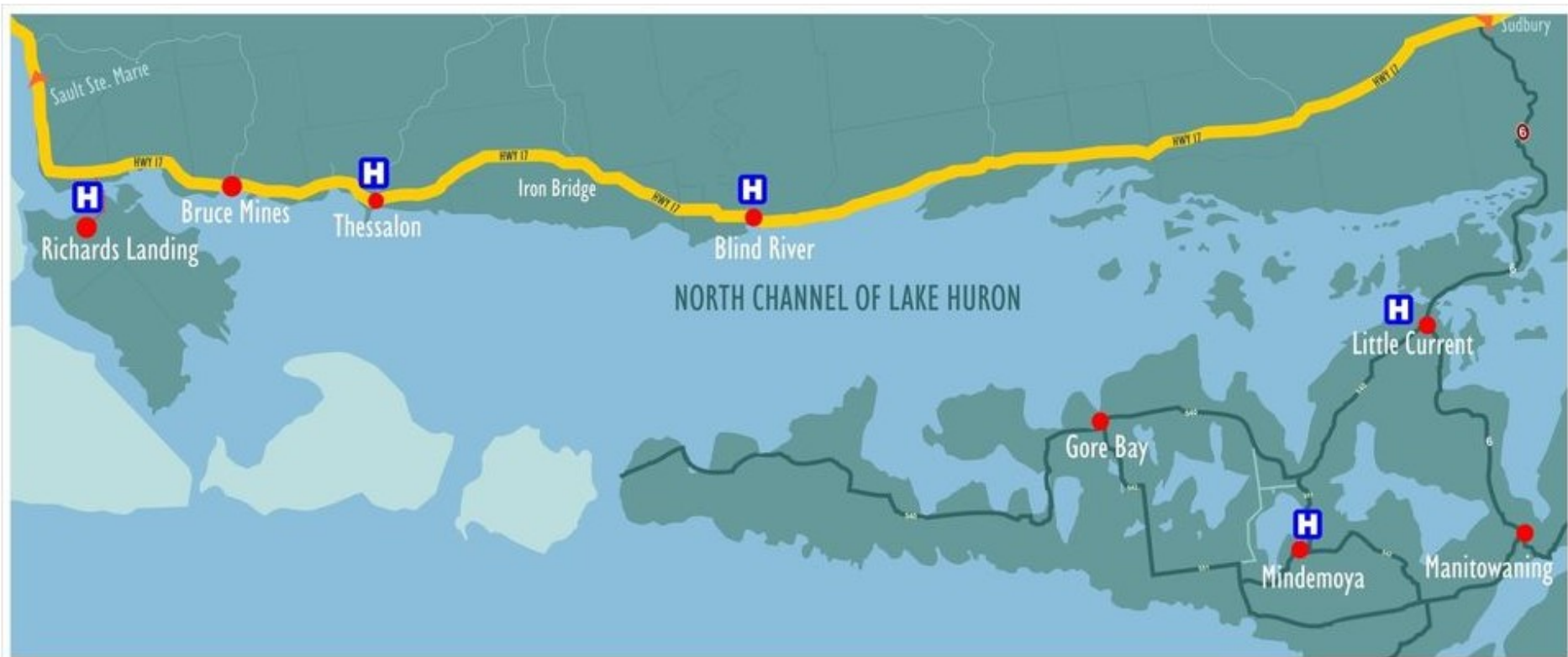

The Little Current Medical Associates (LCMA) is seeking a family physician to join our experienced health care team in January 2022. With a progressive practice and generous incentives, you and your family can enjoy all that Manitoulin has to offer.

This physician position does not require obstetrics qualifications, however, the opportunity to work in low-risk OB is available.

The Northeastern Manitoulin Family Health Team (NEMFHT) is a multidisciplinary team located in Little Current, Manitoulin Island. The team is comprised of seven LCMA physicians, two nurse practitioners, three registered nurses, two registered practical nurses, a pharmacist, a social worker, a dietitian, and three physician assistants.

Together, the LCMA and NEMFHT provides primary healthcare services to the catchment area, including Little Current, three First Nations communities and two nursing homes.

The physicians also provide on-call coverage at the Manitoulin Health Centre; a health centre equipped with a 24-Hour Emergency Department, 16 medical/surgical /peds beds, two combined care (OBS) and day surgery.

Little Current is a scenic town with a population of 1,500 serving 6,000. Its natural beauty and variety makes the Manitoulin area a sought-after recreational destination. Popular pass times include kayaking, fishing, hiking, sailing, cross-country skiing, and snowmobiling. Cultural events include theatre productions, musical evenings, artisan and farmer markets.

Our congenial group of 5 physicians currently has an opening for either one (1) full time or part time physician within a RNPGA1 salaried model. A combination of clinical and emergency services make this an interesting opportunity for a rewarding practice experience.

On-call at our 14 bed local hospital will be 1 in 6 (at full complement), remunerated separately via sessional and HOCC funding. This is a very cooperative team, working in an integrated model with the Manitoulin Central Family Health Team (FHT). The FHT offers the services of Nurse Practitioners, Registered Nurses, Health Promotion, Dietetic, Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Social Work, Traditional Healing and Psychiatry.

The Team provides preceptor teaching to the NOSM, University of Waterloo and Laurentian University, as well as a supportive environment that prioritizes CME for the group. In addition, Monday-Friday daily joint rounds provide an interactive opportunity to discuss care planning for hospital in-patients, emergency and office patients with a interdisciplinary team.

Manitoulin Island is renowned for its beauty and recreational opportunities, in particular, kayaking, boating, sailing, camping, fishing, cycling, hiking, cross country skiing and snowmobiling. Its natural beauty and numerous small lakes make it a sought-after recreational destination.

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Huron Shores Family Health Team is co-located with a Family Health Organization providing primary healthcare services to a catchment area of approximately 6,000 residents.

Our interdisciplinary team consists of a Nurse Practitioner, Registered Nurses, Pharmacists, a Diabetes Education Nurse, Chiropractors, and a Dietitian. We also offer several programs to the community, such as a Smoking Cessation Program and Chronic Pain Self-Management Program.

Located adjacent to the NSHN, physicians at HSFHT provide on-call coverage in the 24-hour Emergency Department and provide medical care to Acute Care in-patients and Long Term Care residents.

Mentorship opportunities with our experienced physicians are available to ease the transition into a full-service practice.

In addition to clinical, Emergency Department, Acute Care, and Long Term Care coverage, physicians at HSFHT actively participate in interprofessional meetings, and can be members of varying committees of the Health Network, and are members of the FHT/FHO Board.

Located along the north shore of Lake Huron, the Thessalon Medical Centre is comprised of two family physicians who are part of the Central Rural Algoma Physicians Group comprised of four family physicians. Together, the physician group cares for a catchment area of approximately 4,500 residents.

They also provide on-call coverage at the North Shore Health Network (NSHN) Thessalon Site. This facility is equipped with a 24-hour Emergency Department and a 4-bed Acute Care Unit.

Adjacent to the NSHN Thessalon site is the Algoma Manor Nursing Home which carries 96 beds, where the physician group provides care to patients on an on-call basis.

This practice opportunity allows physicians to work in clinical, emergency, acute care, and long term care settings, while enjoying ample family time.
