

- 7 Modules:

 - Barriers
 - Physical health needs
 - Mental health needs
 - Intersectionality
 - Inclusive communication
- 3.5 hours for most learners

CME certified courses

- Transition-related hormone therapy in primary health care, 6 hours
- Puberty suppression for trans youth in primary health care, 4 hours
- Transition-related surgeries: planning, referral, and care, 6 hours
- Explains therapeutic options that HCPs can initiate care for trans and nonbinary patients
- Identifies language and best practices in communicating with patients who are trans and nonbinary



- Live online courses
- For physicians, nurse practitioners, registered nurses
- Some courses for pharmacists, physician's assistants, registered social workers, registered psychologists
- Students of respective disciplines are eligible

New, live online courses, 3 hours

- Masculinizing surgeries: postoperative complications in primary health care
- Vaginoplasty: post-operative complications in primary health care

- Transition-related counselling for mental health providers
- Foundations for trans positive counselling: children and youth
- Foundations for trans positive counselling: adults and seniors

- Live online course, 3 hours each
- Each course has a target audience
- Mental health providers and students practicing psychotherapy, counselling, and/or advocacy


