McCausland Hospital & In-patient coverage

McCausland Hospital is a 45-bed accredited facility in Terrace Bay. It serves a catchment area of approximately 3,600 residents from the surrounding communities of Schreiber, Rossport and Pays Plat First Nations Reserve. Thunder Bay Regional Hospital is a 2-hr drive by land and access by helicopter is via ORNGE air ambulance service.



The Hospital has 10 acute care beds and 13 chronic care beds. The Long-Term Care (LTC) facility of Wilkes Terrace is attached to the hospital complex and services 22 beds. Locums cover Acute in-patients and urgent CC/LTC issues for the physician for whom they are covering and the in-patients they admit during their stay. Admitted patients are handed over to their family physician when applicable to do so. The physician on-call covers all acute patients after hours and on weekends. For the most part this will range from 0-5 acute patients.

Diagnostic imaging (x-ray and ultrasound) and laboratory services on-site and are available 24 hrs a day. Physiotherapy, dietician and social work services are available for in-patients and out-patients. Telemedicine and chemotherapy services are also offered.

What is Working in the Schreiber or Terrace Bay Medical Clinic Like?

The North Shore Family Health Team includes two clinics - one in Terrace Bay and one in Schreiber. Each clinic staffs two full time physicians. We also share a nurse practitioner, dietician, social worker/mental health worker and diabetes nurse. Physicians typically see between 10-15 patients per day. Clinic staff is friendly & experienced. On-call physicians are booked more lightly in the clinic and appointments can be cancelled if necessary due to the emergency department situation.

What is On-Call Coverage Like?

Our emergency department is unique in the North in that it is not usually overly busy. Physicians usually take call from clinic, home or outside the Hospital with excellent experienced nurses providing triage services. In an average 24 hour period, the on-call physician can expect 5-10 patients a day. Most patients are low acuity and are often deferred to the clinic or seen the next day.
