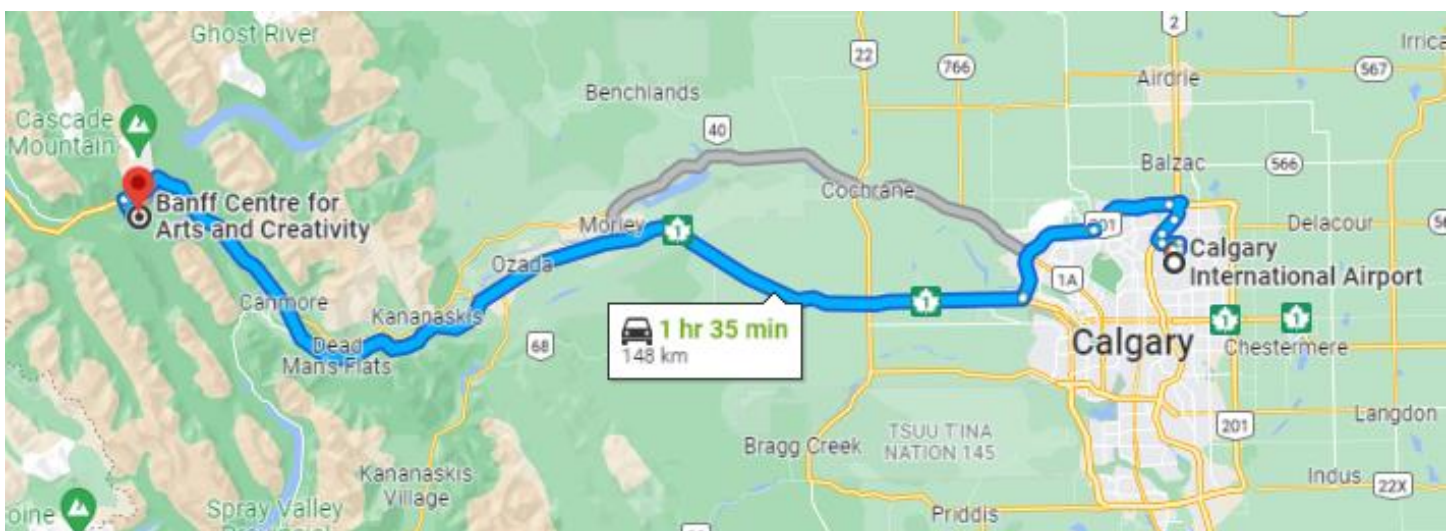
Travel Tips

Airport: Calgary International Airport (YYC) is the closest airport to the conference venue. Plan your flights accordingly. Proof of vaccination is required for air travel in Canada (<https://travel.gc.ca/travel-covid/travel-restrictions/covid-vaccinated-travellers-entering-Canada>).

Banff Airporter: The Banff Centre is approximately 148 km from Calgary International Airport (YYC). The best way to get to the Banff Center is the Banff Airporter. With easy access from the baggage terminal, the Banff Airporter offers door-to-door shuttle service. Round-trip reservations can be made online (banffairporter.com).

Receive a **15% discount** on the Banff Airporter's daily shuttle service between the Calgary Airport and the Banff Centre for Arts and Creativity. On the Banff Airporter website, select Book Now. Proceed through the reservation and type - Ptype2022 - in the "Promo Code?" section on the final payment page to receive the discount.

Traveling by car: The drive from Calgary to the Banff Centre is reasonably easy, and the beautiful mountain views slowly unfold before you as you approach Banff National Park. Please map your preferred route before setting off. As you enter the park, you will be required to purchase a park pass for the number of days your vehicle will be in the park. You can also purchase a park pass online (www.banfflakelouise.com/park-pass-purchase).



Town of Banff: The Banff town site is a short walk from the Banff Centre (see map below). There, you can find all amenities – tourism & information center, grocery stores, pharmacies, pubs, restaurants, breweries, distilleries, art galleries, souvenir stores, etc.

Use the path to walk to Banff town site (#5), or drive to town via Julien Road and Wolf Street or Buffalo Street.
