## ■ THE EVENT

This inaugural edition of the IDIVOSH global forum will focus on the theme Immigration, Diversity of the Workforce, Precariousness and Vulnerabilities in OSH. The event is intended to pursue the development of research programs related to workforce diversity, immigrant workers and occupational safety and health (OSH), and to learn from the various experiments that have been conducted around the world. Due to their sociodemographic or professional characteristics and the work contexts that may be associated with them, these workers run a greater risk of occupational injuries or long-term disability.
