

- The 12-bed Emergency Department sees 20-30,000 annual visits with a wide range of interesting cases!
- Our on-site General Internist manages the highly acute patients in our 4-bed Level 2 ICU, Rapid Assessment and Outpatient clinic
- The newly renovated 3-suite OR is staffed by 3 General Surgeons, 3 GPAs and Visiting Specialists in Orthopedics and Ophthalmology
- The Visiting Specialist clinic provides care locally in Dermatology, Nephrology, Rheumatology, **Endocrinology and Ophthalmology**
- Our 14-bed Schedule 1 facility is one of two in the region and is staffed with on-site Psychiatrist and a dynamic team
- Rural Family Physicians have the ability to work in a variety of areas in the hospital: Surgical Assist, Ortho Assist, ED, Hospitalist, Obstetrics






