







# CanCaN 2021 – Poster Guidelines

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, we are planning a hybrid conference, with the aim of reaching a wider audience. For our in-person guests, poster presentations will be held in our event space at the Alte Aula during the poster session. Additionally, all poster presentations will also be available in video format on our conference platform.

Please set up your poster according to the following guidelines:

# 1) IN PERSON POSTER SESSION:

- Each poster must be printed and brought in by the author.
- Please use an A0 format in portrait orientation (841 x 1189 mm).
- All text should be in English.
- Posters should be mounted on Wednesday, November 17th starting at 11:00 am before the welcoming ceremony at the designated areas (fixing materials will be provided and distributed on-site). If you present a poster, you can check-in early.
- There will be no guided poster tour but presenting authors are kindly requested to be at their posters for discussion during one of the poster sessions:
  - Odd poster ID: Poster Session I on Wednesday 5 to 6 pm
  - Even poster ID: Poster Session II on Thursday 4 to 5 pm
- One poster prize will be awarded by a Poster Prize Committee, so a member might inspect your poster during the poster viewing session. A second poster prize will be awarded based on votes you can give on our website. The poster prizes will be awarded on Friday at 12.15 pm during the poster prize ceremony.

- Each poster must be submitted as an image (identical to the printed version).
  - File size must be 30MB or less (.gif, .png, .jpeg, .jpg)
  - Please upload the image on your submission form online under "Poster image"
  - All participants are welcome to browse the poster gallery online and view all posters on their own time

### • For each poster, a 3 min video presenting the contents must be submitted

- Either guide the viewer through your poster by zooming in on the relevant part or prepare slide show.
- Please provide a video with voiceover, explaining your poster (tutorials can be found online, for example in Microsoft PowerPoint <u>here</u> and <u>here</u>).
- It is <u>not</u> necessary to include a picture-in-picture of the presenting author
- o File size must be 30MB or less (.mp4, .mov, .avi)
- Please upload the video on your submission form online under "Poster presentation"
- For online guests, this will be substituting the poster session, however all
  participants are welcome to view poster presentations online.
- All uploads for the online poster gallery should be completed until Wednesday,
   November 10<sup>th</sup> 11:59 pm.
