DR. ANITA CHAKRAVARTI is a professor with the College of Medicine, University of Saskatchewan, Associate Faculty of the Centre of Integrative Medicine, and a retired anesthesiologist. Having completed her Mindful Practice® certification in New York, she now teaches a framework for mindfulness-based wellness programming for healthcare and human service providers, businesses, and corporations.





DR. NICOLE REDVERS, a member of the Deninu K'ue First Nation, is an assistant professor in both the Department of Family & Community Medicine and the Department of Indigenous Health at the University of North Dakota. She has been actively involved at the international level promoting the inclusion of Indigenous perspectives in planetary health and education for sustainable healthcare.

DR. LINDA RAPSON is a graduate of the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto. She specializes in treating chronic pain by integrating acupuncture and nutrition with conventional medical approaches. 
