Conditions for participation in the competition

- Be a master's or doctoral student
- Present research results
- Respect the presentation rules: maximum 15 minutes with questions, English or French, presence of the Québec-Ocean logo.

| ● Quality of answers: clarity and relevance of explanations | 10 points |
