- Be intentional when “checking off” the programs that you would like to become involved in

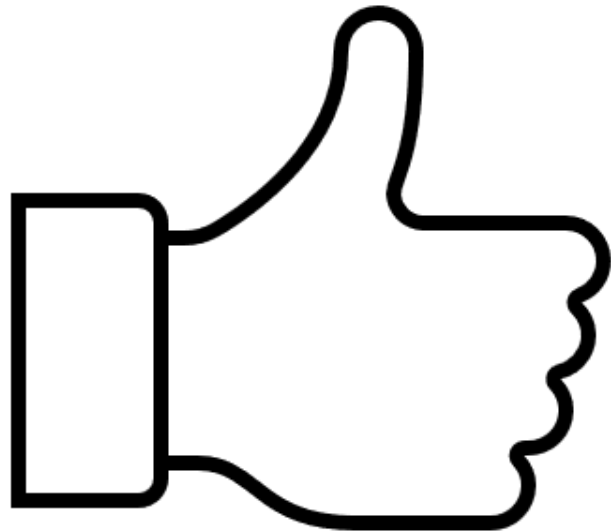
